

Visa Requirements for Azerbaijan

Visa Issuance for UAE Residents

Most passengers with a residence permit issued by the United Arab Emirates can obtain a visa upon arrival for a maximum of 30 days.

They must have:

- An ordinary passport valid for 123 days upon arrival; and
- A residence permit valid for 183 days upon arrival.

Travel Tip: We recommend applying for an e-visa before travel to reduce the waiting time at the immigration counter at the destination. E-visa can be obtained through: <https://evisa.gov.az/en/>.

Info: Visa fee on arrival about 30 USD / e-Visa fee about 27 USD

Exceptions: Nationalities Not Eligible for Visa on Arrival/ E-Visa

- Bangladesh
- Iran
- Iraq
- Libya
- North Korea
- Palestinian Territories
- Refugee status for any nationality
- Somalia
- Sudan
- Syria
- Yemen
